

Biography

Dr. Tenzin Nyima was born in Ravangla, South Sikkim. He did his schooling from central School for Tibetan Darjeeling, West Bengal. From 2002 to 2006 Dr Nyima studied Traditional Tibetan medicine from Men-Tsee-Khang, in Dharamsala. In 2007, he did one-year internship at branch clinic of the institute in Delhi and Dharamsala for six month each, where he acquired specialized knowledge and practical training, working under experienced, senior Tibetan physicians.

After earning his degree in March 2008, Dr. Tenzin Nyima was appointed as a member of a team entrusted with translating *Gyue-shhi* into English. In August 2009, he was transferred to Itanagar branch clinic of Men-Tsee-Khang in Arunachal Pradesh and served as a resident Doctor till April 2011.

From May 2011 to July 2017, Dr. Tenzin Nyima worked as a resident doctor at Ahmedabad branch clinic of Men-Tsee-Khang in Gujarat.

Currently Dr. Tenzin Nyima is a medical officer at Mujnukatilla branch clinic of Men-Tsee-Khnag, in Delhi. Besides doing regular clinical practices, Dr. Nyima writes on Tibetan medicine and also provides health talks. He is an author of "*Tibetan Buddhist Embryology; A Practical Guide for Everyone*". He also did paper presentation in 2012 International conference on Tibetan Medicine, held in Dharamsala.
